### Communication Tip of the Week

#### *Giving praise*

When your child has done something well, give them *specific praise*.

For example, if they followed an instruction as you wanted, in addition to saying "well done", you could say "Well done, I liked how well you listened and did ...".

This lets the young person know what they did well, which helps them to know what the best thing is to do next time.
