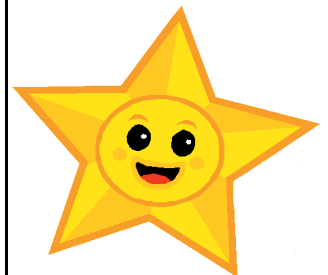
This is a possible national industrial action day. We'll let you know if the school is affected as soon as we hear from the staff unions.
