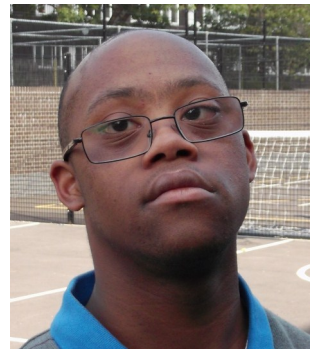
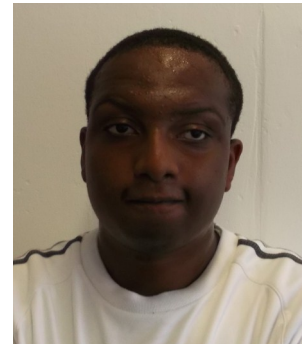
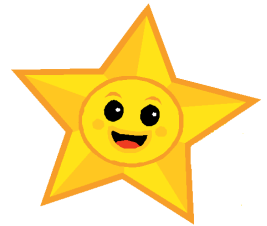
**14S Enterprise are asking for donations of old or unwanted items to recycle into things to sell!**
