Thank you for all your support this term. Yesterday I sent my end of term letter. I hope you enjoyed reading our news. It has been such a busy and enjoyable term.

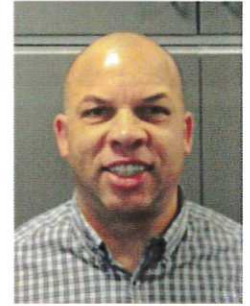
