

11L Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS4 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	<p>Functional Skills- Students will be prepared for the Edexcel English exam- Speaking and Listening, Reading and Writing.</p> <p>Novel- The Girl of Ink and Stars- Exploring the story, characters, maps and adventures. There will be opportunities to develop speaking and listening, reading and writing skills.</p>
Numeracy	<p>To continue to prepare students for Entry level certificate work. In all areas of Maths. Focusing on the first half of Summer term: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication using numbers above 100. More shopping scenarios. Living with money, buying goods and paying bills. Second half Term: Measure and units. What do we use to measure...? Focus on measurements used in the home.</p> <p>To use IXL online maths tasks to extend the areas of learning.</p>
ICT	<p>Students will continue preparing for an Edexcel Functional Skills ICT exam by practicing past papers which test their ability to compose, send and receive emails. In addition they will also be tested on their ability to create and edit documents using Microsoft Office programs.</p>
Science	<p>Pupils will be continuing their 2nd year of study towards their Entry Level Certificate in Science. This term pupils will be studying 'Waves & Radiation'. This will focus on how we 'see' and how we 'hear' and the properties and uses electromagnetic waves. This topic includes lots of experiments related to the above. I recommend the BBC website. Food Tech	<p>Year 11 will continue to work towards accreditation in WJEC: Basic Cooking. They will continue to develop their basic food preparation skills by preparing a range of dishes that reflect the elements of the healthy eating guide, There will be an international twist to the menus that they will create.</p>
Enterprise	<p>Building on the success of their last enterprise, pupils will be developing their skills further by creating their own shakes and salad company. With a view to selling products throughout the school. This will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Undertaking a survey to determine which products will be most attractive to staff.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A termly display and poster/ advertisement. - A video on how to make shakes and salads - A business plan with costs, profit margins, etc. - A written and pictorial record of the progress.
Art	This term we will be exploring how to create and make picture books, design book covers, create stories and illustrate them. We will be experimenting and developing a variety of art skills including sketching, exploring poster and water colour painting colour theory, collage and mixed media. Students will also continue to participate in the ongoing animation project creating story boards, props and characters.
Drama	Improvising. Students to work together improvise and perform pieces of drama. We will look at ways of devising characters and scenarios.
Music	Chance Methods: Compose and develop pieces of music using chance methods.
PE	<p><u>First-term:</u> The pupils will refine their skills and knowledge of the rules of cricket and tennis.</p> <p><u>Second half-term:</u> The group will take part in athletic activities and work towards sports day events.</p>
