

12J Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Students will continue to develop their learning about coins and bank notes to understand money and how/for what money is used for and applying their knowledge/understanding in a practical context.
Functional Literacy	<u>Writing</u> Students will continue developing their skill at writing letters to make words and using those words to write a simple sentence. They will also have practice at speaking in sentences, or phrases, sequencing their ideas in speech, and responding to questions.
ICT	Students will learn how to retrieve, evaluate and organize digital content using a variety of software applications. In the second half of the term students will study Hardware and Processing and come to understand how a range of digital devices can be considered a computer. In addition students will learn about different types of Computer Systems.
Enterprise	This term we will continue developing construction skills in the workshop, using recycled wooden pallets to create garden storage and planter items. Students will learn how to apply their functional numeracy skills in money to enable them to buy resources and sell products. They will be working on recognising coins and notes and using addition & subtraction to make amounts of money; to pay for goods and give change.
Work Experience	Pupils will be working on the school recycling programme. This will include operating and developing the current recycling programme and policy within the school. Pupils will produce a wall display of the work and keep an individual record of their experience.
SRE	This term we will continue to work on the 'Entry pathways accreditation scheme, entry level 2 for Using local Health services in our community. Building on previous knowledge of how to use and access the services of the hospital, GP, pharmacist, clinic and dental services. We will also be visiting a pharmacist and hospital environment, and interviewing the school nurse.

Music	The group will continue working on a Soundtracks project. They will explore how different types of music can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
Art & Craft	This term we will be exploring decoupage, applying decoration to boxes, picture frames & bowls, creating original designs which draw on students personal interests.
Food Tech	12J will be preparing food using a variety of skills, and demonstrating that they know which skills to employ for which jobs and which tools are used. These skills will be adapted and applied to the various international styles of cooking which range from South America, the Middle East and the Far East.
PE	The pupils will continue to visit a local leisure facility to improve their water skills. They will also be introduced to the fitness facility at the centre. For their Fitness Lesson; students will be continuing to learn to line dance.
