

12M Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Students will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and about measurement; using cm and m to calculate area and perimeter. A link will be made with money, using both skills to solve simple money problems for example how much will it cost to erect a fence around the garden and to carpet a room? Later in the term students will be sitting their Entry Level Functional Skills exam in Numeracy.
English Printed Product	English Pathways- Students will be learning about the features on the front covers of various media products. Annotating and analysing effects. Conducting class surveys about film posters and magazine readership. Changing media products appearance and explaining ideas. Creating a media product.
Life skills	<p>Pupils will continue to follow the entry pathways course on plant maintenance and gardening skills. In order to achieve their qualification, pupils will complete the following tasks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Produce a wall display outlining their progress in setting up a maintaining the school garden. - Produce scale drawings of the garden beds and a planting and maintenance schedule or scheme of work for the garden. - Pupils will record their progress using photographic evidence for their work portfolios. - Produce a display of the work e.g. flowers in pots within the school. - Produce vegetables, flowers and herbs for sale within the school. - Produce individual portfolios of their work for accreditation.
Enterprise	The class will be making saleable items from recycled materials with continuing focus on decorative glass, sun catchers & mobiles.
ICT	Students will continue preparing for an Edexcel Functional Skills ICT exam by practicing past papers which test their ability to compose, send and receive emails. In addition they will also be tested on their ability to create and edit documents using Microsoft Office programs.
Music	The group will continue working on a Soundtracks project. They will explore how different types of music

	can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
Art	This term we will be exploring how to create and make picture books, design book covers, create stories and illustrate them. We will be experimenting and developing a variety of art skills including sketching, exploring poster and water colour painting colour theory, collage and mixed media. Students will also continue to participate in the ongoing animation project creating story boards, props and characters.
SRE	12M will continue to work on their Entry level pathways module of 'Parenting Awareness', level 2/3. This involves demonstrating a knowledge of what the emotional and physical stresses are on new parents; what support services are available to new parents; what financial help is available; health and safety and recognising and responding to medical issues in young children. Students will work on power point presentations, designing leaflets and posters to illustrate this knowledge.
Food Tech	12M will be preparing food using a variety of skills, and demonstrating that they know which skills to employ for which jobs and which tools are used. These skills will be adapted and applied to the various international styles of cooking which range from South America, the Middle East and the Far East.
PE	The pupils will continue to use the fitness facilities at a local leisure centre as well as receiving hockey coaching from an external coach. For their Fitness Lesson; students will continue to follow the T-25 Workout Programme.
