

13/14A Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Students will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and about measurement; using cm and m to calculate area and perimeter. A link will be made with money, using both skills to solve simple money problems for example how much will it cost to erect a fence around the garden and to carpet a room? Later in the term students will be sitting their Entry Level Functional Skills exam in Numeracy.
English Audio-Visual Texts.	English Pathways- Studying the film The Force Awakens. Students will be describing and analysing the types of characters in key scenes. Analysing plot and plot line, analysing favourite scenes. Novel- Five Hundred Miles by Kevin Brooks. Reading and analysing plot and characters.
Enterprise	This group is engaged in two projects; making Business Cards for Southwark Council and making 'Grow Cards', for sale to the public. They also have a special client 'Bee Urban', a local social enterprise group, who they will be making bespoke cards for. The key concepts 'Entrepreneurship', 'The Value of Money' and 'Work Skills' will underpin this subject.
Life Skills	Pupils will continue to use multimedia resources in class. This will include the production of a short video describing their own personal interests. All pupils will complete a module on anger management In addition, as a group, pupils will produce posters and wall displays on three key themes. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Anger management - Personal hygiene - Emotional intelligence
SRE	13/14A will continue to work on their Entry level pathways module of 'Parenting Awareness', level 2/3. This involves demonstrating a knowledge of what the emotional and physical stresses are on new parents; what support services and what financial help is available; health and safety and recognising and responding to medical issues in young children. Students will work on power point presentations, designing leaflets and posters to illustrate this knowledge.

Music	The group will continue working on a Soundtracks project. They will explore how different types of music can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
PE	The pupils will begin to use the fitness facilities at a local leisure centre working towards having a knowledge of leisure facilities and how to keep fit and healthy in their own time outside of school hours.
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised internal and external work experience placements at a variety of venues including Harrisons and Just Hospitality catering and Mind charity shop in Dulwich.
College Link Course	Students are attending a one day link course at LESOCO college. Courses are studied on a termly rotation and this Spring students will be taking courses in Retail studies, Catering, Office skills and Sports studies.
