

13/14L Summer Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	WJEC Entry Pathways- Students will be studying the film The Force Awakens. Students will be describing and analysing the types of characters in key scenes. They will be analysing plot and plot lines and analysing their favourite scenes.
Maths	To measure, practical activities, weights and distances in kilograms, grams, centimetres and metres. To measure real-life problems, paper activities. To measure area, and perimeter. To collect data and represent in graphs, pie charts, and Venn diagrams. Fractions, mixed numbers, addition and subtraction without common denominator. Decimals addition and subtraction. Shape names. Measurement of angles, particularly in triangles and rectangles. Odd and even numbers. Rounding to the nearest 100.
Computing	Students will complete work from the Information Technology module; where they have been learning how to use Microsoft Office programs such as Word, Publisher, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint . The majority of the term will be spent practicing exam papers in order to prepare for a Pearson EDEXCEL Functional Skills Exam . This exam will test the student's abilities to send and receive emails, edit Word and Excel documents and to follow instructions.
Textiles	Working with recycled plastics, weaving and sewing.
Art	This term students will be experimenting with a variety of mixed media, stencil printing and modelling materials to explore sea creatures. We will be mixing and practising brush work using water colour and poster paints to create water patterns. Students will look at picture book illustrations and work in small groups to select and make their favourite characters
Music	Students will learn to work as a group to select, practice and ultimately perform a song or piece of music for a school

	communal event, such as an assembly. Each member of the group will be assigned a musical instrument and will learn to play their part, along with their classmates.
Drama	Pupils will build on current and develop new drama skills including teamwork, devising, improvisation, using physical theatre techniques and performance. The pupils will also build on their current drama skills with role play and characterisation work using the film <i>The Force Awakens</i> as a basis for securing knowledge, skills and new learning
PE	During part of the term the group will visit the Elephant and Castle Leisure Centre to take in a Cricket programme run by Surrey Cricket. The aim is to inspire and hopefully feed some of the group into the Surrey Disability Cricket team. In order to improve independence and healthy lifestyle routines, the group will also continue to use the Gym facilities at Camberwell Leisure Centre on a regular basis
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including Yahoo!, Just Hospitality Catering, Darwin Court Healthy Living Centre and Roots and Shoots. There will be additional opportunities for visits and workshops throughout the year.
Enterprise	Continuing on a recycling/upcycling theme we will be marbling items for sale. Continuing with the Promoting Businesses on Social Media Training (from Tennis To Be) we will be looking at how to photograph and promote items made in Enterprise to attract a wider customer audience.
