

13K Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	To continue developing students for functional maths. Concentrating on basic number, addition and subtraction. Continue to recognise coins and notes. Finding ways of solving money problems. Shopping scenarios. What do we use money for? Second half Term: Measure and units. What do we use to measure things in the home? Telling the time. Using a calculator on your phone.
English Film Studies	The more able pupils will continue with graded written comprehensions covering a wide range of literature. All pupils will have intensive practice in phonological skill using Wordshark, Nessy, the Swap cards, and other aids.
Enterprise	The class will be making saleable items from recycled materials with particular focus on felt making, paper making and fabric recycling.
Life skills	<p>Pupils will continue to develop their self awareness and social skills. All pupils will complete worksheets and a portfolio called About Me which will be their personal profile. Pupils this term will be looking at anger management skills and personal care routines. Pupils will continue to keep a record of their achievements in individual files.</p> <p>In addition, as a group, pupils will produce posters and wall displays on three key themes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Anger management - Personal hygiene - Emotional intelligence <p>Pupils will also be reviewing school policies on internet safety, personal space and general rules within the school environment</p>
SRE	13K will continue to work on their Entry level pathways module of 'Parenting Awareness', level 2/3. This involves demonstrating a knowledge of what the emotional and physical stresses are on new parents; what support services and what financial help is available; health and safety and recognising and responding to medical issues in young children. Students will work on power point presentations, designing leaflets and posters to illustrate this knowledge.

Music	The group will continue working on a Soundtracks project. They will explore how different types of music can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
Art	This term we will be exploring how to make picture books, design book covers, create stories and illustrate them. We will be experimenting and developing a variety of art skills including sketching, painting colour theory, collage and mixed media.
Food Tech	This term the class will be developing their cooking and business skills by running an enterprise food stall selling different seasonal dishes to staff and students. The topic includes aspects of marketing such as conducting surveys, advertising and customer service.
PE	The pupils will continue to use the fitness facilities at a local leisure centre.
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including Southbank Mosaics, Harrisons and Just Hospitality catering and Mind charity shop in Dulwich.
