

14C Summer Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	To continue to develop students for functional maths in their everyday lives. Concentrating on basic number, addition and subtraction. Recognising coins and notes. Finding ways of solving money problems. Shopping scenarios. Living with money. What do we use money for? Second half Term: Measure and units. What do we use to measure our homes? Using our phones in maths.
Functional Literacy	<p><u>Writing</u> Students will continue developing their skill at writing letters to make words and using those words to write a simple sentence; using vocabulary (both what they know and new) to describe what they see.</p> <p><u>Speaking & Listening</u> Students will design and prepare presentation to give to others about the things they have done or a book that they have read; with each student being able to ask questions on what they have heard and the presenter to answer those questions.</p>
Enterprise	The class will be making saleable items from recycled materials with particular focus on beads and jewellery making.
Life Skills	Every week 14C travels to a local supermarket to do some shopping for the school's Breakfast Club. Each student is responsible for buying one or more items individually.
SRE	14C will continue to work on their Entry level pathways module of 'Parenting Awareness' level 2. This involves demonstrating a knowledge of what the emotional and physical stresses are on new parents; what support services and what financial help is available; health and safety and recognising and responding to medical issues in young children. Students will work on power point presentations, designing leaflets and posters to illustrate this knowledge.
Music	The group will continue working on a Soundtracks project. They will explore how different types of music can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
Art	This term we will be exploring how to make simple books, looking at book covers and collecting pictures and memories from our Highshore school and using collage skills.

Food Tech	This term the class will be developing their cooking and business skills by running an enterprise food stall selling different seasonal dishes to staff and students. The topic includes aspects of marketing such as conducting surveys, advertising and customer service.
PE	<p>Pupils will receive tennis coaching in school, with some students working towards visiting the Craic Cup in July.</p> <p>The will also begin to visit a local leisure centre to make use of the fitness facilities there.</p>
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including Roots & Shoots horticulture project, Harrisons and Just Hospitality catering, Clapham children's centre and The Ministry of Justice.
College	Students are attending a one day link course at LESOCO college. Courses are studied on a termly rotation and this Spring students will be taking courses in Retail studies, Catering, Office skills and Sports studies.
