Dinner Money

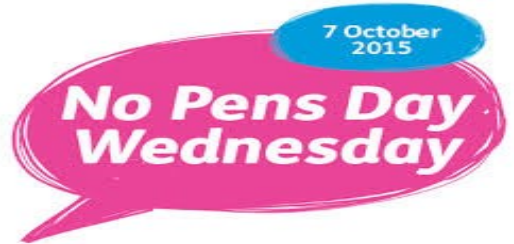
We would like to remind parents that Dinner money should be paid weekly and in advance where possible.

Dinners are £1.80 per day, which is £9.00 per week.




