

13J Spring Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Pupils are developing functional skills in number, money, time and measurement. The emphasis is on applying these skills in everyday situations and increasing confidence in problem solving with mathematical 'know how'.
English Printed Products	Exploring types of newspapers and magazines. Analysing Front Pages and stories. Designing a survey about readership of magazines and newspapers.
Enterprise	Pupils will continue to develop their carpentry skills by working on creating stackable plant containers from wood recycled from wooden pallets. This term we will be using stencil decoration techniques.
ICT	First half-term: Pupils will learn to use a variety of digital music packages to compose, mix and perform their music creations. Second half-term: Pupils will be preparing for functional skills exam.
Music	Continuing the introduction to Garageband on the iPad, pupils will work in 2s learning to create a song using a template with 2 or 3 chords, with focus on a structure that includes chorus, verse, bridge & instrumental.
Food Tech	1 st half term – We will continue to run the Buff Bites catering company and we will refresh our menu of filled rolls to sell to staff each Friday. We are using the money we make from our enterprise company to pay towards our residential trip this term.
Art	Create a printed media product- Magazines. Producing a magazine cover based on their research and analysis from their English lessons. Sketching, drawing and collaging their ideas to create a magazine cover.
PE	In this unit pupils use facilities / practitioners within the local community to experience indoor and outdoor leisure activities. Pupils in 13J will attempt to collect evidence to obtain WJEC accreditation in Healthy Living and Fitness. This term there will be a particular focus on 'yoga'.

Lambeth College Link Course	Pupils are working in the construction department at the Vauxhall site. Each term they study a different course in either painting and decorating, carpentry or bricklaying.
Work Skills	Pupils will be exploring some of the options available them post 19. We will examining skills and interests and developing self- presentation skills.
PSHE	2 nd half term – pupils will be studying Parenting Awareness. They will be introduced to some of the issues facing new parents and will identify sources of help and support for new parents.
Life Skills	Pupils will learn the fundamentals of first aid. They will learn the meaning and aims of first aid, what is in a first aid kit and how to deal with minor injuries such as a minor cut, minor burn, nose bleed, how to help someone who is choking...
