

13S Spring Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Pupils are developing functional skills in number, money, time and measurement. The emphasis is on applying these skills in everyday situations and increasing confidence in problem solving with mathematical 'know how'.
English	The Dark Hunter novel- Exploring setting, characters and genre.
Enterprise	Continuing on a recycling/upcycling theme we will be making felt brooches from donated woollen clothing and broken jewellery. Also using donated cotton duvets and pillow cases to print/hand paint and make bags. Making handbag charms from donated broken jewellery.
DRAMA	Classic films. Pupils to watch classic movies that have become widely known such as Jaws, Star Wars, and also classics such as The Great Escape, One Flew over The Cuckoo's nest. Pupils will also act scenes and discuss the themes of the films.
Music	Continuing the introduction to Garageband on the iPad, pupils will work in 2s learning to create a song using a template with 2 or 3 chords, with focus on a structure that includes chorus, verse, bridge & instrumental.
Life Skills	Personal Safety in the Home and Community. The group will use discussion, role play, watching and making instructional videos to help recognize risks they might face at home and when travelling locally. Part of the Entry Pathways Accreditation.
Art	Entry Pathways Art and Design- 'Painting and Drawing' Exploring decorative and illuminated lettering to make a painting to celebrate their name and identity.
Food Tech	Second half-term topic 'Winter Warmers': Pupils will be exploring how to use a variety of seasonal vegetables to create different dishes to be enjoyed in cold weather. Pupils will create their own recipes based on ingredients they like.
Lambeth College Link Course	Pupils are working in the construction department at the Vauxhall site. Each term they study a different course in either painting and decorating, carpentry or bricklaying.
