

13/14A Spring Term 2017 Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Functional Numeracy	Students will be learning to tell the time; using both analogue and digital clock. Using this knowledge students will learn how to solve problems that involve using time; for example reading a bus/railway timetable and working out the length of time for their journey.
Literacy	WJEC English Pathways-Audio- Visual Texts. Studying Chicken Run- story and characters. Completing three assessment tasks. Studying The Force Awakens- exploring and commenting on how characters are presented, what they represent.
Enterprise	This group is engaged in a project making 'Grow Cards', using seeded paper for sale to the public. They also have a special client 'Bee Urban', a local social enterprise group, who they will be making bespoke cards for. The key concepts 'Entrepreneurship', 'The Value of Money' and 'Work Skills' and will underpin this subject.
Music	The group will be working on a Soundtracks project. Firstly they will explore how different types of music can alter the mood of a film. Once they have decided on a genre they will make a short film and create an appropriate soundtrack to accompany it.
PE	First half-term: Pupils will be visit a local youth centre to undertake a six week course in boxing with a qualified coach. Second half-term: Pupils will use a local leisure centre gym to improve their cardio-vascular fitness and strength.
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including Glengall Wharf garden, Harrisons and Just Hospitality catering, The MIND charity shop and onsite ICT & Office support.
College Link Course	Students are attending a one day link course at LESOCO college. Courses are studied on a termly rotation and this Spring students will be taking courses in Retail studies, Catering, Office skills and Sports studies.
