On Wednesday our leavers assembly was as always a moving occasion. Thanks go to parents and former colleagues who joined us.




On Thursday Kathy and 14C ran a stall at Borough Market. Thanks go to Jackie our parent volunteer who supported the pupils. The total raised was around £70.
