

13/14L Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	Students will be following the WJEC accredited course - Audio/ Visual texts. They will be studying the films Chicken Run and Star Wars – The Force Awakens. They will be acquiring/ practicing various skills such as brainstorming and storyboarding.
Maths	Number work, highly differentiated addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; from number bonds up to 50 to calculations involving 5 digit numbers, use of the carrying procedure, use of calculators, decimal points; and application to real life problems involving units of: money, time, length, and weight.
Computing	Students will learn that computers use Binary Code to represent all digital data. They will then learn how to convert basic Binary code to Denary and carry out simple calculations. In addition Students will prepare for an EDEXCEL ICT exam by continuing to use various software to create, store and edit digital content using appropriate file and folder names.
Food Tech	In the first half term students will be extending their basic food preparation skills preparing different sauces and soups on the hob. In the second half term we will be preparing a variety of foods that can be sold at the Christmas Enterprise market such as preserves, iced edible decorations and traditional sweets.
Art	Looking at "Food in Art". Using artist imagery and still life work to inspire personal Art Works with focus on form or colour which can be used as greetings card designs or postcards.
Drama	Improvising and devising stories and performances. Students to work together to produce short dramas about topics of their own devising. Students to work on short scenes and performances of their own devising. They will work together either as a whole group or in small groups, choosing a director and using lighting and sound/music to enhance their performances
Music	Students will learn to use a combination of analogue and digital musical instruments to learn or compose a piece of

	music with the intention of performing it in an Assembly. There will be a particular focus on rhythm and tempo.
PE	<u>Off-Site PE</u> In this unit pupils use facilities in the local community to experience indoor and outdoor leisure activities. Taking into account interests of the students we promote positive attitudes towards an active and healthy lifestyle.
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including Yahoo!, Just Hospitality Catering, Darwin Court Healthy Living Centre and Roots and Shoots. There will be more opportunities for visits and workshops throughout the year.
Enterprise	Making silhouette and marbled paper Christmas cards and novelty gifts. Taking part in selling opportunities.
