

14K Autumn Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	Students this term will be following a WJEC accredited course and will be studying the topic Communicating Experiences. They will be developing their skills of communication in a variety of ways including presentation and role play.
Maths	<u>Functional skills Maths Entry level 1 and foundation Maths.</u> Baseline assessment. Revise number bonds, estimation, and inverse of numbers. Identify sums of money and use it in real life situations. Understand and read an analogue and digital clock. Associate, reading times with real life situations, timetables. Understand measure and mass. Read scales. Calculate area. Understand the unit of length and capacity. Learn to use a calculator. Using a mobile phone for maths. IXL Maths and Mathletics.
Computing	Students will learn that when a computer does something it is following instructions called Code. They will then write, or program, their own Code and create their own basic games and apps. They will learn to work logically, systematically and identify mistakes. In addition Students will also focus on computers safely and responsibly, knowing a range of ways to report unacceptable content and contact when online.
PSHE	This year 14 class will be working on self and respecting others skills. Students will try to identify personal strengths and explore and agree on areas of development. Students will also focus on preparation for work skills. Students will focus on skills and qualities needed for work life and recognise personal career opportunities.
Textiles	Working with Wool – Finding out where wool comes from and it's uses in both spun and unspun state. Exploring felt making. Cutting, stitching and bonding felt to make Quiet Books. Experimenting with knitting and crochet.
Music	Students will learn to use a combination of analogue and digital musical instruments to learn or compose a piece of music with the intention of performing it in an Assembly. There will be a particular focus on rhythm and tempo.

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PE	<u>Off-Site PE</u> In this unit pupils use facilities in the local community to experience indoor and outdoor leisure activities. Taking into account interests of the students we promote positive attitudes towards an active and healthy lifestyle.
Work Experience	Students are participating in individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including The London School of Mosaic, Harrisons Catering and Groove School. There with more opportunities for visits and workshops throughout the year.
Social Communication	This term the students will be learning about Giving and Following instructions with the theme of First Aid. They will be working on their own, in pairs and in group situations and by the end of the term will have produced a First Aid instructional video.
Enterprise	Making silhouette and marbled paper Christmas cards and taking part in selling opportunities.
