

Attendance Summary

Those classes marked in orange or yellow are achieving over the School's target figure of 95% during this last half term, those in red are under that figure, only 5 classes have achieved over that figure in the last half term, with 7E having an impressive 99.54%.

Unfortunately the very bad start we had to 2018 has continued, as we have one pupil with no attendance at all, two persistent absences below 50%, one below 60% and four below 70%, these absences have affected the overall figure for the half term keeping it below 94%, but because we have an amazing **62** pupils with 100% attendance during this period, the attendance is up for this half term to 93.57%. A good improvement on the last half term.


This means that the whole school attendance figure for this school academic year has also affected in a positive way, and is now up at 92.96%, although this makes the achievement of our 95% target for this school year still unlikely, another good half term like this will see us near the previous years' figure, giving us something to build on the next school year.

If our new Year 7 pupils are as good attenders as the this years' group we will be very happy, with 7E and 7L consistently in the top classes of attendance every week.
