Dear Parents and Carers,

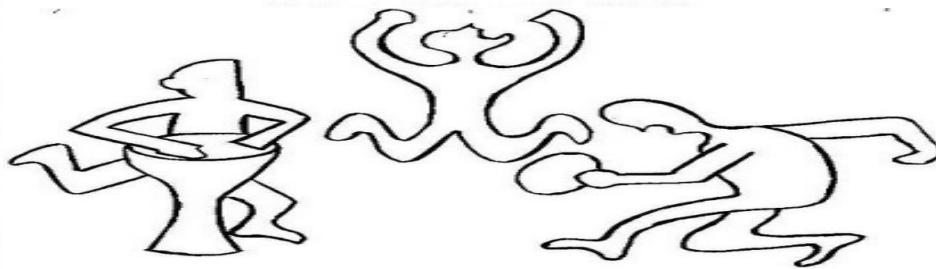
Our Annual International Evening will be on:-
