

13/14L Summer Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be studying the following topics in their KS5 curriculum.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	The Class start written tasks around Romeo and Juliet. They will continue with graded written comprehensions covering a wide range of literature. They will have intensive practice in phonological skill using Wordshark, Nessy, and the Swap cards.
Maths	Students will be continuing to work on their functional skills and completing WJEC entry pathway work. This term they will continuing to work on money time and measurement. They will be using the Mathletics program to supplement their learning.
Computing	<p>Students will complete work from the Information Technology module; where they have been learning how to use Microsoft Office programs such as Word, Publisher, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint.</p> <p>The majority of the term will be spent practicing exam papers in order to prepare for a Pearson EDEXCEL Functional Skills Exam. This exam will test the student's abilities to send and receive emails, edit Word and Excel documents and to follow instructions.</p> <p>Later in the term, students will learn about Boolean logic.</p>
PSHE	<p>Safety at home</p> <p>This term students will be exploring different aspects of safety at home and in the community. Topics will include: common dangers in the kitchen, bathroom, and garden as well as situations when we are out exploring the local area. Some aspects of Road Safety and safety when using public transport will be revisited. This term we will also explore e-safety and safety around strangers.</p> <p>Students will be taking part in role-play activities trying to act out potentially dangerous situations and demonstrate measures they will have to take to protect their health, well-being and their rights as individuals.</p>
Drama	Student will be using drama and role play to explore Interview techniques and speaking confidently in front of an audience. Pupils will build on current and develop new drama skills including devising, improvisation and performance.

Music	This Term we will be learning about and using a variety of Steel Pans and preparing musical items for the summer music festival.
PE	The group will continue their fitness programmes at a local leisure centre. All of their previous activities through their time in 6 th form will be used towards their WJEC Entry level awards in Preparing for Physical Activity, Frequent and Regular Exercise and Team Games.
Work Experience	Students are continuing with individualised work experience placements at a variety of venues including OATH, Fooditude Catering, Darwin Court Healthy Living Centre and ALDLife Charity shops.
Enterprise	Continuing on a recycling/upcycling theme we will be printing items for sale. Continuing with the Promoting Businesses on Social Media Training we will be looking at how to photograph and promote items made in Enterprise to attract a wider customer audience. We will also be managing the stock ordering and distribution in teams.
