

Class 7A - Summer Term Curriculum Overview

This term pupils will be staying with their class teachers who will deliver a variety of subjects and topics as part of our *Recovery Curriculum*.

Subject	Topic
Literacy	<p>This term the students will be finishing their Spring topic by exploring books such as 'Brenda's boring egg' and 'The Cautious Caterpillar'. They will then be starting a seaside and holiday topic.</p> <p>They will be using this stimulus to write in various ways including messages, postcards, letters and descriptive sentences.</p> <p>There will also be lots of opportunities to develop their reading, writing and speaking and listening skills.</p>
Numeracy	<p>Students will be exploring place value. We continue with number through addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. In weights and measurement we will be exploring money and weight and volume, Students will get the opportunity to do hands on activities.</p>
PSHE	<p>Developing a healthy, safer lifestyle - Personal Hygiene.</p> <p>This term pupils will continue developing their self –confidence, understanding their responsibilities and making the most of their abilities by learning new life skills. Students will be learning about their body parts and then the importance of personal hygiene and different equipment to keep clean. Lessons would involve - learning the steps of washing hands and the reasons why we have to wash them and learning the correct techniques of brushing teeth. They will also explore topics related to puberty and the changes teenagers go during this sensitive time.</p>
Science	<p>In science this term students will learn about plant science. They will take part in a sunflower growing project across key stage 3, and will complete a range of activities about the plant life cycle and how to look after plants.</p> <p>In the second half of the term students will learn about electricity. They will learn about what electricity is and how it is used.</p>
Computing	<p>We will continue to explore the topic, what is a computer, exploring what computers do for us every day. The students will revisit the basic computer skills that they will need in order to be able to use a tablet, desktop or laptop computer.</p>
Music	<p>Students will explore using apps to create music. They will also continue exploring the sounds of instruments.</p>
Life skills	<p>This term students will be continuing to learn and practise a number of life skills to help them in daily life. Topics will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Making a drink and snack.• First Aid

Play skills and Social Communication	Students will develop their social skills through playing games in small groups. We will continue to explore positive forms of communication.
Art and Craft	This term students will be exploring the art and works of the painters Georgia O 'Keefe, Vincent Van Gogh and Frida Kahlo and looking at the natural world. Term 2- We will be looking at the seaside and beaches.
Fitness	Pupils will work on developing their strength and flexibility with an aim to improve their overall fitness. This will be taught in the hall and in the Fitness room.
Humanities	This term students will be looking at the city of London in preparation for London Day. They will be exploring the different parts of the city including famous landmarks.
