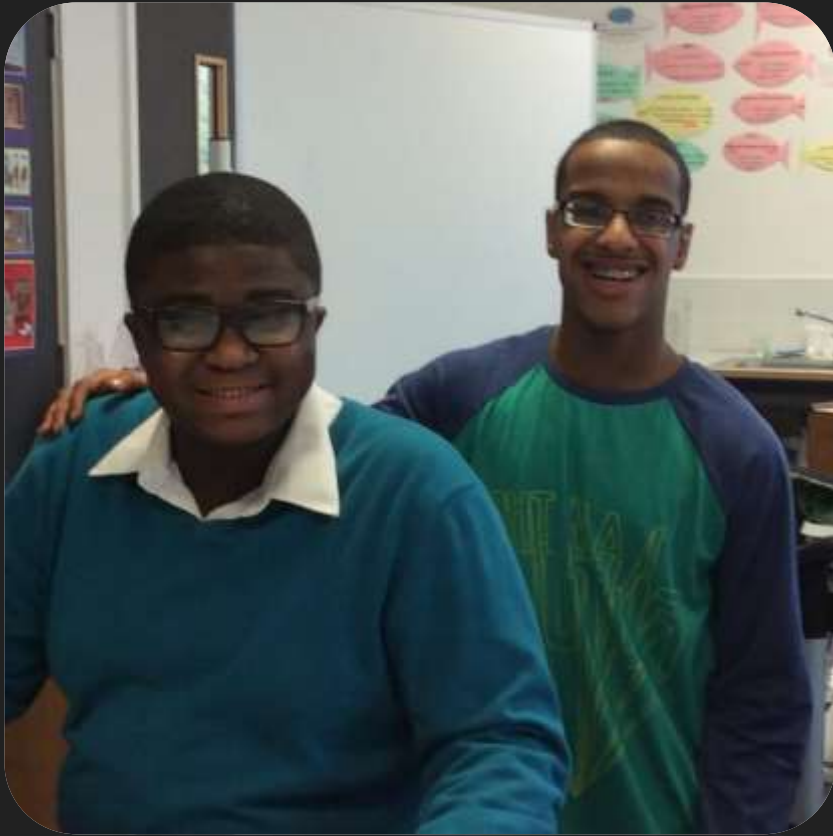

Individual Supported Placement Applications

- ISPs go to Southwark panel for funding – panel meets at fixed points in the year
- But you need to apply for a place before going to panel
- SLT members (Sally Brett, Julia Manning, Eileen Ollieuz) will help with applications for ISP placements
