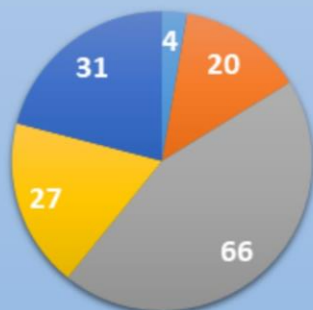

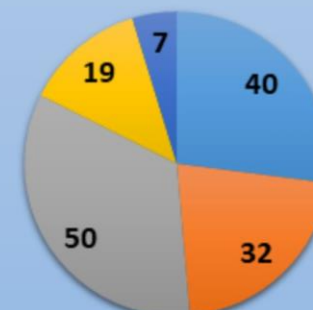
Parent Survey Results (15/5/20)

Q1: If the school was to reopen on 1st June I would want my child to return



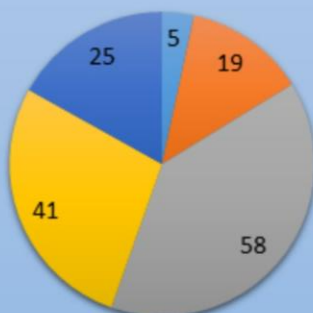
