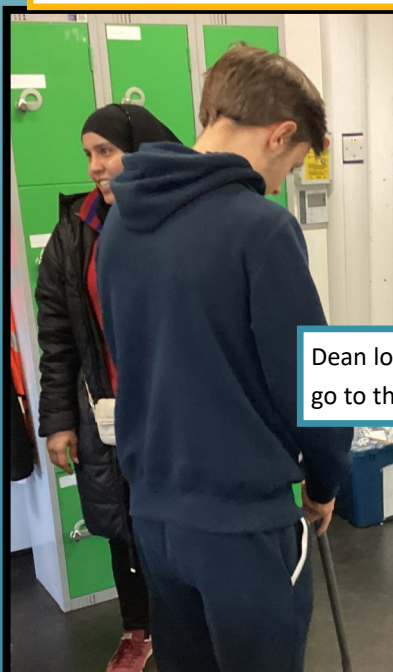

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Class—based Work experience

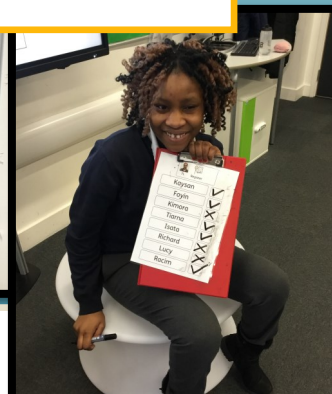
In line with our updated careers' curriculum, all of our pupils take part in Classroom-based work experience as they move through the school—here are some examples!



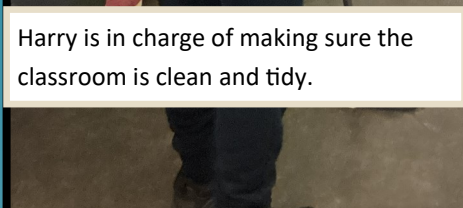
Dean looks after the hob when 13L go to their offsite placement.



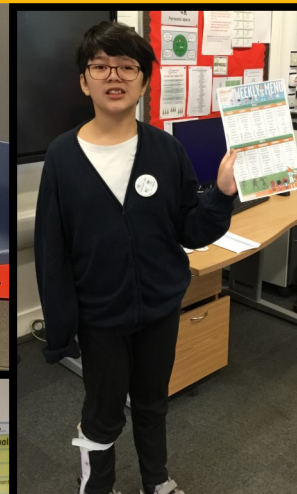
Many pupils take care of the daily time-table for their classes.
